Jamboree Heights State School will receive

\$312,209

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving the **National Minimum Standard** in Years 3 and 5 within **all strands** to 100%
- Increase the percentage of students in the **Upper Two Bands for Reading** in Year 3 and 5 to 70% and 55% respectively
- Increase the percentage of students in the **Upper Two Bands for Writing** in Year 3 and 5 to 65% and 40% respectively
- Increase the percentage of students in the **Upper Two Bands for Spelling** in Year 3 and 5 to 65% and 55% respectively
- Increase the percentage of students in the **Upper Two Bands for Grammar and Punctuation** in Year 3 and 5 to 65% and 50% respectively
- Increase the percentage of students in the **Upper Two Bands for Numeracy** in Year 3 and 5 to 60% and 42% respectively

Our initiatives include

- Consistent and effective use of **research-based practices for teaching reading** such as shared reading, guided reading and reciprocal teaching
- **Modelling, coaching** and providing effective **feedback** for teachers
- Developing a consistent and effective approach to the **teaching of writing and vocabulary** incorporating student **learning goals and feedback**
- Maintaining the school's **Explicit Teaching model** (Archer) and the use of **Core Skills**
- Responding to the **extension and enrichment** needs of identified students as well as embedding **Higher Order Thinking** strategies in the planning and teaching processes
- **Data conversations** with year level teams and individual teachers using consistent and valid data collection tools to analyse, respond to, and monitor student progress
- Strengthening **case management** of students requiring learning support and extension
- Creating a **strong foundation in the early years** with specific programs such as motor development, fine motor, oral language, and phonological awareness for targeted individuals and groups of students along with age-appropriate pedagogies
